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BILL SUMMARY

SENATE RESOLUTION 20, PN 174 (SENATOR PIPPY)

Summary:

This resolution directs the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a study to determine the effect of the Commonwealth's tax credit programs on the Commonwealth's economy, job market, and state and local tax revenues. The study will include the following tax credits:

- Neighborhood Assistance Programs
- Employment Incentive Payments
- Homeowners' Emergency Mortgage Assistance Fund
- Job Creation Tax Credit
- Research and Development Tax Credit
- Keystone Opportunity Zone
- Coal Waste Removal and Ultraclean Fuels Tax Credit
- Educational Improvement Tax Credit
- Keystone Innovation Zone
- Film Production Tax Credit (*via Amendment*)
- First Class Cities Economic Development District
- Organ and Bone Marrow Donor Tax Credit
- Strategic Development Areas
- Resource Enhancement Protection Tax Credit
- Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association Credit
- Property and Causality Insurance Guaranty Association Tax Credit
- Emergency Tax Credit
- Call Center Credit

Report:

The Legislative Budget and Finance Committee shall report all findings to the Senate no later than one year from the date of the passage of the resolution.
