18 (d.1) Additional application components.--As part of the
19 application under subsection (d), each association shall comply
20 with all of the following:

21 (1) An association shall file an annual report with the
22 licensing authority. The following shall apply:

23 (i) The first annual report required under this
24 paragraph shall contain information for the 12-month
25 period ending at least 60 days, but not more than 90
26 days, prior to the submission of the application.

1 Subsequent annual reports shall contain information for
2 the most recent 12-month period ending in the same month
3 as the initial report.

4 (ii) The annual report shall concern the operation
5 of bingo games by the association and shall detail gross
6 receipts from the conduct of bingo games, the expenses
7 related to the conduct of bingo games, the prizes paid
8 out for bingo games and the details as to how the
9 proceeds from bingo games were used or disbursed by the
10 association.

11 (iii) The annual report shall be prepared on a one-
12 page form to be designed by the department. Additional
13 schedules shall be included, if necessary, to provide
14 specific details on the use or disbursement of the net
15 proceeds from bingo games by the association.

16 (2) An association shall provide evidence to the
17 licensing authority that bingo games education has been
18 completed under this paragraph. The following shall apply:

19 (i) Two hours of education shall have been completed
20 within the 12-month period immediately preceding the date
21 of the application.

22 (ii) The education shall have been completed by the
23 executive officer, secretary or a responsible person
24 listed on the association's application for a license.
25 The person receiving the training shall be associated
26 with the conduct of bingo games by the association.

27 (iii) The contents of the education program shall be
28 determined by the department and shall be designed to
29 assist associations in their compliance with statutory
30 and regulatory requirements associated with the conduct
31 of bingo games.

32 (iv) The education program may be conducted by any
33 Statewide nonprofit association approved by the
34 department.

35 (v) This paragraph shall not apply if the
36 association submits an affidavit affirmed by the
37 executive officer or secretary of the association that
38 the association will not conduct bingo games on 30 or
39 more days during the licensing period.

3 than one year after the effective date of this section.
