AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 2493

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 24, by striking out "and" and
2 inserting a comma

3 Amend Bill, page 1, line 26, by inserting after "System"
4 and for solicitation of political contributions; and
5 making a related repeal

6 Amend Bill, page 10, by inserting between lines 18 and 19
7 Section 4.1. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
8 Section 110.1. Solicitation of Political Contributions.--(a)
9 This section applies to a person or an affiliated entity that
10 does any of the following:

11 (1) Enters into a professional services contract with the
12 system or any municipal pension system in this Commonwealth.

13 (2) Submits an offer for or bids on a professional services
14 contract with the system or any municipal pension system in this
15 Commonwealth.

16 (3) Responds to a request for proposal on a professional
17 services contract with the system or any municipal pension
18 system in this Commonwealth.

19 (4) Otherwise solicits a professional services contract with
20 the system or any municipal pension system in this Commonwealth.

21 (b) A person or an affiliated entity subject to subsection
22 (a) may not solicit a contribution to a municipal official or
23 candidate for municipal office where the municipal pension
24 system is organized or to the political action committee of that
25 official candidate. The prohibition under this subsection
26 applies to any agent, officer, director or employee of the
27 person or affiliated entity.

28 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section:

29 "Affiliated entity" has the meaning given in section 701-A of
30 the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1005, No.205), known as the
31 Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act.

32 "Professional services contract" has the meaning given in
33 section 701-A of the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and
34 Recovery Act.

1 Section 21. Repeals are as follows:

2 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
3 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of
4 section 110.1 of the act.

5 (2) Section 703-A(b) of the act of December 18, 1984
6 (P.L.1005, No.205), known as the Municipal Pension Plan
7 Funding Standard and Recovery Act, is repealed.
