Statewide Red Light Camera Act

An act authorizing the use of red light cameras for traffic violations by any municipality in the Commonwealth.

Section 1. This act shall be known as the Statewide Red Light Camera Act.

Section 2. Beginning January 1, 2019, any municipality is authorized to utilize red light cameras in order to enforce traffic violations. Any municipality who chooses to utilize red light cameras must:

- 1) Pass a referendum of all eligible voters in the municipality
- 2) Provide notice of red light camera locations
- 3) Provide an annual report to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation detailing the impact of red light cameras in the municipality.

Section 3. Effective Date: This act shall take effect on January 1, 2019.
